



The Waidner Coat of Arms, originally of a mountain clan in Tyrol, was first known to be held by two brothers, Urban Waidner of Tyrol and Adam Waidner from Kirchsureth, Bavaria, who studied under Rector John Fodocus Lucius, Doctor and Professor of Philosophy and Medicine in Heidelberg in 1609, and also Wolfgang Waidner of Strassburg in 1520.

The Coat of Arms consists of a prancing red steer in a silver shield on a gray footing with a black rim, draped with red and silver.
